Independence Day Facts

In 1777, thirteen gunshots were fired, once at morning and again as evening fell, on July 4 in Bristol, Rhode Island. Philadelphia celebrated the first anniversary in a manner modern American would find quite familiar; an official dinner for the Continental Congress, toasts, 13-gun salutes, speeches, prayers, music, parades, troop reviews and fireworks. Ships were decked with red, white & blue bunting.

In 1778 General George Washington marked July 4 with a double ration of rum for his soldiers and an artillery salute. Across the Atlantic Ocean, ambassadors John Adams & Benjamin Franklin held a dinner for their fellow Americans in Paris.

In 1791 the first recorded use of the name "Independence Day" occurred.

In 1931, Congress changed Independence Day to a paid federal holiday. The residents of Vicksburg, Mississippi, celebrated Independence Day for the first time since July 4, 1863, when the siege of Vicksburg ended with a Union victory during the American Civil War.



Ace Of Hearts Rules

1 ticket for \$1 or 8 for \$5 - Must be a member in good standing - **MUST PUT YOUR NAME ON THE TICKET EXACTLY AS ON YOUR CARD** - Drawing will be on every Monday at 7pm - If you get any ace but the ace of hearts then you get 10% of the pot - If you get a joker then you get 15% of the pot - If you get the ace of hearts then you get the total pot if present. 50% if not present in the Post for the drawing - Legion gets 20% of the weekly amount taken in - Tickets are sold every week - 3 tickets will be drawn every week, ticket #, ticket # & ticket # - 1st Ace of Hearts, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$20 gas card - All winning tickets will be paid off in Legion Stars & Stripes Points. If the name is not exact or is illegible the ticket will be disqualified. A card will still be turned for that draw. If the turned card is an ace or other than the ace of hearts, or a joker, the winnings will not be paid and the stars & stripes points will roll to the next draw. If the turned card is the ace of hearts, the game will end, all stars & stripes points to date will roll to a new game.
