Important Notice

At our August General Business Meeting, the issue of the new Post being non-smoking came up. After much discussion, a motion was made, seconded and approved by the membership present that a vote on the subject would take place at our September General Business Meeting. Post 318 Legion Members will have the opportunity to choose 1 of 3 options presented at the August meeting:

- 1: Keep the policy the same as it currently is, canteen area plus outside patio.
- 2: Smoking area restricted to within 4 foot of the bar top and outside patio areas only.
- 3: No smoking except on outside patio area.

This will be decided by a majority vote of the members present at the September General Business Meeting. In order to vote, you must have a current membership in the Legion, have your membership card with you, and you must attend the meeting. To avoid long lines in signing the meeting log, the log will be available at the Canteen door for sign-in during the time the Executive Board meeting is in session. Upon entering the Meeting Hall, you must present your Membership Card to the Sergeant-at-Arms to ballot. If the numbers of members attending exceeds the amount of room available in the Meeting Hall, then the meeting area will be expanded to include the Canteen area, the bar will be closed and anyone who is not a Legionnaire with a current membership card will be asked to leave the building until such time as the General Business Meeting has adjourned.
